Pray this prayer with me

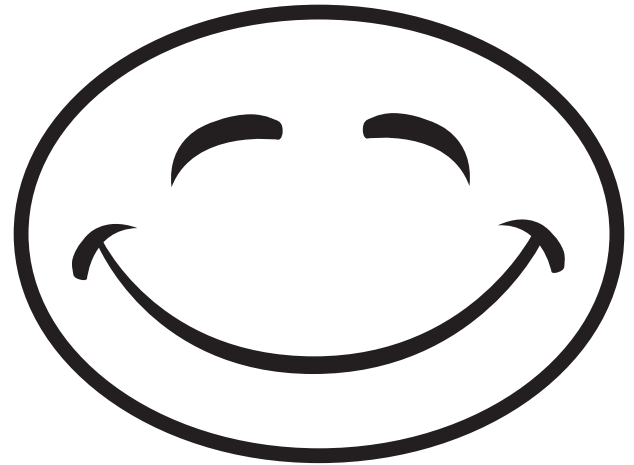

Four Healing Truths About Jesus.

Jesus' Purpose (John 10:10, 1 John 3:8)



Smile 1: Isaiah prophesied your healing

“But he was wounded for our transgressions (sin), he was (deeply) bruised for our iniquities (depravity): the chastisement (punishment) of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.” *(Isaiah 53:5 KJV)*

“But the LORD chose to crush him by disease”

(Isaiah 53:10 Tanakh)

“As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man (Jesus) be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son (Jesus), that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” *(John 3:14-16 KJV)*

700 years before Jesus was born, God showed the prophet Isaiah that Jesus, the Son of God, would be beaten with a whip as a redeeming payment for humanity's sickness and disease.



Smile 2: Jesus confirmed Isaiah's prophecy

“And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge (beat with a whip), and to crucify him: and the third day he shall rise again.” *(Matthew 20:19)*

While speaking to His disciples one day, Jesus confirmed Isaiah's prophecy concerning the stripes and bruises that would be laid upon His own body. Stripes that would legally pay for the healing of humanity. This beating was so terrible He was no longer recognizable. *(Isaiah 52:14)*



Smile 3: Pilate activated your healing

“Then Pilate therefore took Jesus, and scourged him.”

(John 19:1 KJV)

“And when he (Jesus) had given thanks, he broke it (the bread of communion), and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.”

(1 Corinthians 11:24 KJV)

When the Roman whip touched Jesus' back, the authority of sickness and disease was forever broken. As blood began to pour out of Jesus' wounds, a river of mercy began to flow to humanity from Heaven that has never stopped. Jesus' stripes were for our sickness and disease. If Satan had understood the cross (where God paid for humanity), he never would have crucified Jesus.

(1 Corinthians 2:8)



Smile 4: The Apostle Peter proclaimed healing

“Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree (cross), that we, being dead to sins (through our faith in Jesus), should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.” *(1 Peter 2:24)*

“That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare (carried away) our sicknesses.” *(Matthew 8:17)*

Isaiah prophesied healing, Jesus confirmed it, Pilate activated Isaiah's prophecy, and now, we proclaim it with the Apostle Peter. Jesus not only took our sins upon the cross, but He also paid for our sickness and disease. Right now, release your faith in Jesus and ask Him for His healing mercy. Be quick to repent of any sin and believe in His goodness. Remember, with God, nothing shall be impossible. *(Matthew 19:26)*
